Missouri Food Pantry Tax Credit (MO-FPT)

Any taxpayer (individual, corporation, or trust) making a donation of cash or food supplies to a food pantry may receive a credit of up to \$2,500 per taxpayer per year. Taxpayers may take a credit of 50 percent of their donations. Example: Donate \$1000 to FMP before year end and take up to a \$500 credit on your 2019 tax return. A Missouri (MO-FPT) form may be requested by calling Cathy, 314-631-4900 x 307.
